At class this week I mentioned several book titles and resources that you might be interested in as you progress in learning Koine Greek. I've listed these below so that you have exact bibliographic data.

### *Lexicons & Dictionaries*

Bauer, Danker, Arndt, Gingrich. *A Greek - English Lexicon of the New Testament and other Early Christian Literature*, Third Edition (Univ of Chicago Press, 2000).

[This is the standard Lexicon for NT Greek]

Moulton, James Hope, and Milligan, George. *The Vocabulary of the Greek Testament* (Eerdmans, 1972). [This has also been reprinted by Hendrickson Publishers]

Liddell, Henry George and Scott, Robert. *A Greek-English Lexicon* (Oxford, 1973). [This is the standard Lexicon for Classical Greek.]

Newman, Barclay. *A Concise Greek-English Dictionary of the New Testament* (United Bible Societies, 1971). [This is a handy dictionary for reading the Apostolic Scriptures in Greek.]

*The UBS Greek New Testament: A Reader's Edition* (United Bible Societies, 2001). [This is the UBS 4th Edition of the Greek NT, with running dictionary at the bottom of each page listing words that occur more than 30 times in the NT. It is available in softcover and in hardcover.]
